

Summary of Work in Guatemala with National Restoration Roundtable in Support to the NDC

The project team supported the Guatemala government to consider landscape restoration as a Nature-based Solution to climate change and include it in its NDC. In that sense, the project team with support from national consultants, supported different workshops with national stakeholders and prepared documents with recommendations to the roundtable and the government, on the use of NBS to support NDC commitments. The activities and products are available below:

First National Restoration Roundtable Meeting and Workplan for 2021: During the first 2021 meeting of the roundtable, the convened stakeholders discussed the priority actions and workplan for the rest of the year. Some of the prioritized areas include: NDC commitments, monitoring, guidelines for the restoration of riparian forests, conservation of native species, and the national course on restoration.
